Nothing Is Impossible

“Truly, truly, I say to you, he who believes in Me, the works that I do, he will do also; and greater works than these he will do; because I go to the Father. Whatever you ask in My name, that will I do, so that the Father may be glorified in the Son. If you ask Me anything in My name, I will do it.” John 14

The modern space age began on this day in 1926, when Robert Goddard launched the first liquid-fuel rocket. In the next several years, he went on to develop new applications for a wide variety of inventions to improve rocket performance. He had done what others thought impossible, but, ironically, his work was virtually ignored in the United States.

In fact, few people recognized the significance of his discoveries until the German military successfully used V-2 rockets during World War II. Finally, after the war, Goddard’s work began to receive attention. Eventually, he became recognized as the father of modern rocketry.

In many ways the significance of the empowerment of the Holy Spirit has gone unnoticed by many. The experience of believers today being baptized in the Holy Spirit is neither taught nor understood.

Today, many Christians do not realize the extent of the power that God has made available to them. They may read the Bible and go to church. They may pray and believe in God, but they still place limits on Him, or simply feel that His power is not available to them.

However, the Bible reminds us of the words of Jesus: If any person believes in Him, we can do even “greater works” than He did while He was on earth. We can ask for “anything” in His name! Anything!

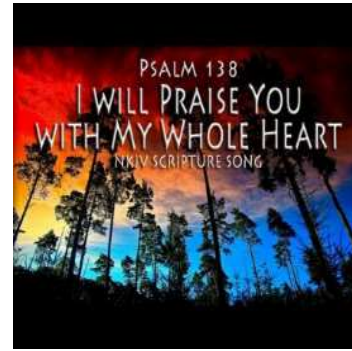
Right now, do you face problems that seem to be impossible? Do you know someone else who is facing serious needs? Do you feel that without the intervention of the miraculous much will be lost?

Then begin to use the faith that God has given you, Start declaring God’s Word to be true. Accept the challenge of Jesus: “Ask me, and I will do whatever you ask” (v. 13). Whatever!

So be bold and ask! Declare His promises to be true in your life. Don’t be crippled by doubt, and don’t limit either the Him.

“Father, I ask You to meet needs today, first for others and for myself. I believe that nothing is impossible for You and that You will answer my prayer. I have faith in You. Thank You. In Jesus’ name. Amen.”

Worship with Your Whole Heart

I will cry to God Most High, Who performs on my behalf and rewards me [Who brings to pass His purposes for me and surely completes them]!

(Psalm 57:2 Amplified Bible)

Great worship leaders know to come into the presence of God with their entire being, prepared to give thanks and praise (see **Deuteronomy 10:12**). They don't just roll out of bed, throw water on their face, and run a comb through their hair before church. They know that the anointing comes from a sincere pursuit of loving God with their whole heart.

Likewise, as you approach God in the morning, come to Him with a heart full of worship, expressing your awe of Him for His faithfulness toward you. He promises that He will never forsake you, but will be with you all day long (see **Joshua 1:5**).

Find Quiet Time - The [reverent] fear of the Lord is clean, enduring forever; the ordinances of the Lord are true and righteous altogether. More to be desired are they than gold, even than much fine gold; they are sweeter also than honey and drippings from the honeycomb. (**Psalms 19:9-10** Amplified Bible)

Sometimes I set aside the entire day just to be with God. I stop everything and seek Him. I know I am not going to hear from God if I don't get quiet on purpose by that time set aside for Him.

It is so important to have some "down time" to be alone and just sit quietly. You may think you don't have time, but if somebody was giving out thousand-dollar bills at the mall, you would find time to get there. Don't use the time to try to figure out something; just be still and available to the Lord's attention.

Increase Your Days - Behold, the Lord's eye is upon those who fear Him [who revere and worship Him with awe], who wait for Him and hope in His mercy and loving-kindness, to deliver them from death and keep them alive in famine. (**Psalms 33:18-19** Amplified Bible)

When I talk about seeking God early, many people think they will have to get up at three o'clock in the morning! I am not trying to tell you how to do it. I am not even suggesting that you pray for an hour. I am just saying that some way, somehow, if you want to start your whole day right, you must find time to seek God's wisdom in the morning.

Time with God adds years to your life! God is eager to give us insight and understanding. His Word says, "For by me [Wisdom from God] your days shall be multiplied, and the years of your life shall be increased." (**Proverbs 9:11** Amplified Bible)



Bringing Every Thought Captive

Most of the struggles that we face in life are really inner ones. The outward battles are normally a result of deep inner conflicts that have been built over a lifetime.

If we are to truly experience victory over habits and wrong patterns of actions, then we must learn to undergo a transformation of our inner thoughts and feelings.

The Apostle Paul wrote in 2 Corinthians 10:5, “We demolish arguments and every pretension that sets itself up against the knowledge of God, and we take captive every thought to make it obedient to Christ.” Paul was speaking of the spiritual battle that every Christian faces. He understood that the greatest conflicts of life are spiritual ones, and that the battleground is always the mind of the believer.

Before a person comes to know Christ in a deeply personal way, the Bible says that he is a captive or slave to sin. In other words, our entire outlook and view of life is built upon attitudes and thought patterns that are contrary to God’s plan for us. We build those patterns of thoughts over months and years.

When we come to know Christ, that doesn’t mean that we no longer have to deal with wrong thought patterns. It simply means that we are no longer slaves to those patterns. But we must learn to “take every thought to make it obedient to Christ.”

God has given you weapons of spiritual warfare to overcome Satan’s stronghold on your life. Begin today to bring every thought captive unto the obedience of Christ because you can do it if you want to.

The bakery evidently lost, smudged or otherwise misread the noted reference, and beautifully inscribed on the cake “John 4:18”...

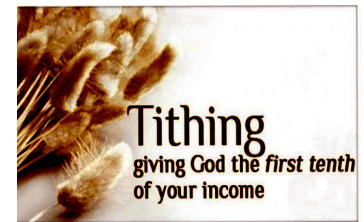

Bringing God Tithes Malachi 3:8-12

God has set forth very specific directives about what He expects us to give back to Him. Malachi 3:8-12 clearly teaches that we are to give Him a tithe, which is ten percent of what we produce or earn (the word *tithe* is based on the number ten in Hebrew).



The children of Israel gave such a generous offering at the time they built the tabernacle that Moses actually had to tell them to stop giving ([Ex. 35:4-36:7](#))! The tithe is given to God *from* our increase and *for* our increase. It is our acknowledgement that all we have and all we are able to achieve comes directly from the hand of God ([Mark 12:41-44](#)).
