Faithfulness has always been a rare quality (Psalm 12:1; Proverbs 20:6; Philippians 2:19-22).

Most people don't know the meaning of commitment. They make commitments casually, then break them for the slightest reason without any hesitation, remorse, or regret. Every week, churches and other organizations must improvise because volunteers didn't prepare, didn't show up, or didn't even call to say they weren't coming.

Can you be counted on by others? Are there promises you need to keep, vows you need to fulfill, or commitments you need to honor?

This is a test. God is testing your faithfulness. If you pass the test, you're in good company: Abraham, Moses, Samuel, David, Daniel, Timothy, and Paul were all called faithful servants of God.

Even better, God has promised to reward your faithfulness in eternity. Imagine what it will feel like one day to have God say to you, "Well done, my good and faithful servant. You have been faithful in handling this small amount, so now I will give you many more responsibilities. Let's celebrate together!" (Matthew 25:23)

By the way, faithful servants never retire. They serve faithfully as long as they're alive. You can retire from your career, but you will never retire from serving God.

Not everyone will hear those words of greeting into heaven. Only those who have been found faithful. Will you be among those welcomed in such a warm and special way?

### Seeing the Good in the Bad



One of the greatest verses in the Bible is found in Romans 8:28 – “*And we know that in all things God works for the good of those who love him, who have been called according to his purpose.*”

We know it, and many of us can quote it from memory. We believe it, and stand on it... that is, until we face a “bad time” in our life! When the rubber meets the road of life and we get tested in our faith.

During difficult times, we can often lose our focus, forgetting that we serve a God who truly loves us and cares for us, providing for us, and meeting all our needs according to His riches in glory. Sometimes it seems that the clouds of doubt descend and surround us until we feel lost in a fog and wander aimlessly and without clear direction.

God is still God – even in what we may think are “bad times”!

We are limited in how we see and assess our life’s situations. We naturally can only see and understand from our own perspective and point of view.

But, from God’s perspective, He has promised to never leave us, never forsake us, and He is a friend who sticks closer than a brother!

He can – and does – take even what the enemy means for harm, and will use it for good!

### ***You Want To Be In God’s Will...Is He In Yours?***

God Word commands us, “*Lay not up for yourselves treasures upon earth, where moth and rust does corrupt, and where thieves break through and steal: But lay up for yourselves treasures in heaven, where neither moth nor rust does corrupt, and where thieves do not break through nor steal: For where your treasure is, there will your heart be also*” (Matt. 6:19-21).

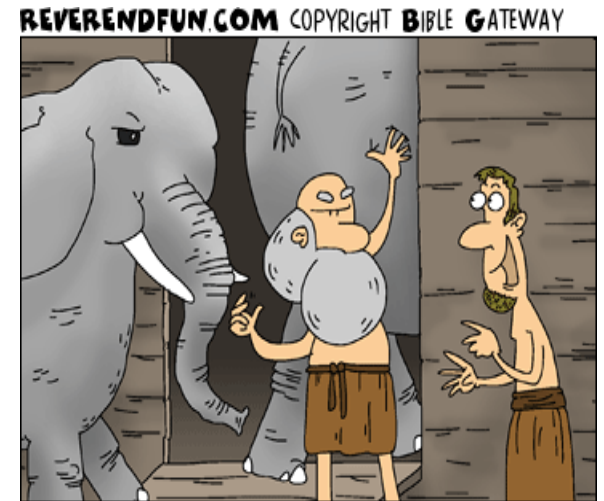
By planning ahead in writing your will and choosing to leave part of your estate to the ongoing work of God’s Church, you can continue to fulfill God’s purpose even after your death. Sometimes I like to ask, “*You want to be in God’s will... Shouldn’t He be in yours?*”

Your Last Will and Testament can stand as a final act of good stewardship. Oftentimes a designation of the tithe, or simply one-tenth of your estate will far exceed beyond many tithes and offerings given at their present value. When we specify a portion of our inheritance to God first, we honor not only Him but our family and friends as well.

God Himself has told us that everything belongs to Him: “*The earth is the LORD’S, and the fullness thereof; the world, and they that dwell therein*” (Psa. 24:1). As good stewards, we must seek God’s will in deciding what we do with His gifts. We know that God accomplishes His purpose through those who seek to do His will, and that He has “*has put in [our] hearts to fulfill His will*” even after we are gone! (Rev. 17:17).
